Created by Edoardo Carlino, an emerging figure on the Italian design scene, the Hi-Can is furnished with a host of technical treats making your bed a one-stop shop for lazy weekends.

A state-of-the-art sound system, PC, full multimedia capabilities and projector have been built into the frame to allow users to play video games, surf the net or

play high-definition movies on the bed's drop-down home-cinema screen.

The touch-technology control panel on the headboard can also be linked to home security, light or temperature systems. No wonder the Hi-Can's been labelled "the geek's second home inside the home".

There's no word yet on price, but the first models will be available in six months and you can even customise your own design.
